6P INTERNATIONAL RECEIVES NDLS REGIONAL TRAINING CENTER CERTIFICATION

6P International joins an elite group of less than thirty Training Centers nation-wide that have been approved by the National Disaster Life Support Foundation (NDLSF) as Regional Training Centers. An NDLS Regional Training Center designation is the second highest level of training center available from the National Disaster Life Support Foundation. The achievement of NDLS Regional Training Center allows 6P International to conduct the internationally recognized Disaster Life Support curriculum of courses including: Basic Disaster Life Support, Advanced Disaster Life Support, National Disaster Life Support-Decontamination, and National Disaster Life Support-Instructor.

The NDLS Foundation

Since the terrorist attacks of 2001, demand has increased for a nationally recognized course in “all-hazards” training to better prepare health care professionals, emergency response personnel, and others for mass casualty incidents. To meet this need, a coordinated “all-hazards” training program was developed by a consortium with financial support from a Congressional Appropriation through the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). The members of this consortium are the Medical College of Georgia, the University of Georgia, the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas, and the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston, School of Public Health.

In order to oversee the rapidly-growing program, the principals established a non-profit foundation, the National Disaster Life Support Foundation™ (NDLSF™), in 2004. The NDLSF™ is responsible for the establishment and accreditation of a national network of training centers. The AMA is the sponsoring and continuing medical education (CME) accrediting organization for this initiative as well as the publisher of the texts.
